

Title and abstract Bulgarian, English and Spanish

Reports - Bulgarian, English and Spanish

REQUIREMENTS FOR PRESENTATION OF THE REPORTS:

Papers, surveys, methodologies, student papers, expert reviews, scientific papers, short reviews of newly published books, brief summaries of protected dissertations with contributions to science and practice in the field of sport, sports at school and recreation are accepted.

The papers to be sent on the following e-mail: sport@swu.bg.

The materials and scientific papers received may be reviewed provided they have not been published or are not currently available in other scientific journals or collections. Reports submitted at scientific meetings will be accepted for consideration if they have not been published in the Forum or the Conference Edition.

The editorial has the right to make language changes to the text. The papers are reviewed by specialists in the field.

Technical requirements:

- The text to be in MS Word for PC; Times New Roman; 12 pt or Arial - 10 pt; fields - 2 cm; spacing between rows: single. The format is A4 (21 x 30 cm), 60 characters per line. Do not apply hyphenation (transfer) to the text.
- The title is written in capital letters (Center). Below it (in lowercase letters, without abbreviations and no titles) - personal and family name of the author or authors.

- The tables should be submitted in a format that can be edited. A format is preferred in Microsoft Word or Excel. Each table is numbered in Arabic numerals and a short title is included for the substance of the data in the table. All footnotes, if any, should be placed under the table.
- Figures and illustrative material: Place the images in real or slightly larger sizes than the size of the publication (3.5 x 7 inches width (9-18 cm), with a text size proportional to the image. Remove the built-in white spaces around the image. The linear layouts, such as charts and charts, should be submitted in the form in which they were originally made (eg, Microsoft Excel, Power Point) so they can be corrected.
- Photographs or halftone images are submitted as JPEG TIFF, EPS, or files with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi.
- Illustration layout - xls (for MS Excel graphics); cdr (painted in CorelDraw, version 9); eps as the text is vectorized; tiff (for scanned images, the size is close to real, and the resolution is not less than 300 dpi.) (The magazine is black and white, please make sure your images (tables, figures, patterns) are black and white).
- The bibliographical reference is based on BDS and the Official Oral Dictionary of the Bulgarian language (2012, p. 124–130).

Volume of the articles.

- It is desirable to have the works within 3500 and 5000 words, including tables, figures and bibliographical references. In individual cases (large-scale surveys), materials up to 7000-7500 characters are acceptable.

Organization of the articles

The cover page must include:

- a) a title in Bulgarian language, under which the title is also written in English;
- (b) below the names and surnames of the author or authors;
- (c) an institution, university, etc., in which the author (s) works or is a member;
- d) the name of the author's e-mail address where the correspondence will be held after editing and who will communicate on behalf of the editorial team of the article, and when there is more than one author, he is written at the end of the article as well as the names of the others authors with their scientific or academic degrees, if any.

Abstract in English language:

It should include the title of the article, the name (s) of the author / authors, keywords followed by the abstract, which should not be more than 150-200 words (20 lines).

- The abstract should summarize the main points of the article, the purpose of the study, the methods used, the concrete results and the conclusion. It is written in English. The translation of English is an absolute responsibility of the author.
- It should not exceed 20 lines at a standard page size. It should include: purpose, methodology, results, conclusion and keywords.

The exposure:

- For the sake of clarity of the presented materials, the following structure should be observed: the introductory part, the hypothesis, the purpose and the tasks, the methodology (for the reports from the experimental studies), the analysis of the results, the discussion, conclusions, recommendations, bibliographical reference .
- It is permissible to use descriptive title and subtitles that can be written in smaller font or numbered.

- The results and discussion can be in separate points, but they can also be merged.
- In the text, the literary sources are represented with square brackets that correspond to the number with which the respective source is written in the bibliographic reference - eg. [2, 5].
- The tables and figures should be bound in the text and marked with circular brackets - eg. (Table 2) (Fig. 3).

Bibliography:

- The bibliography should only contain authors quoted in the text.
- The authors are arranged and numbered in alphabetical order (by the first name of the first author).
 - When the literature is mixed from literary sources in Cyrillic and Latin, it is first arranged in Cyrillic, then in Latin.
 - It is recommended that the number of sources per article should not exceed 20, with up to 40 articles for reviews.
 - Sources with 3 or more names can be referenced by the first or the first two authors and added to them "and co." or "et al."
- The authors are responsible for the accuracy and completeness of the bibliographic reference.
- The first name of the first author, comma, the initials of the small name. All other authors have their surnames followed by the initials.

When the authors are many, then after the first one, and perhaps after the second one, you can write "and co" or "et all". The entire title of the cited article follows. After that, the name of the magazine, the book number, or the volume, the home and last page numbers. The magazine information, number, year, and pages are displayed with a comma.

Examples:

In a magazine:

Ivanov, V., Kostov, D. European Athletics Championship. // Athletics, № 3, 2010, p. 20-25

In collection - name of the author (s), title of the material, item, collection name, point, place of publication, publishing, year of publication, pages. Between the title of the material and the name of the collection it is written: Rusev, R., Ivanov, S. Regarding the need to reorganize the educational system. - In: col. Humanizing the pedagogical process. International Scientific Conference. Blagoevgrad, 1993, pp. 222-225.

In a book

When citing a book, the following order is followed: authors' names, book title, place of publication (city), publishing house, year of publication, pages.

Meranzov, Hr. The Golden Age of Bulgarian Sport. Sofia, Tangra TanNakRa IK, 2012, p. 50.

Notes:

When the title of the material has a subtitle, they are separated by a colon.

Until recently, the city of the publication was written only initially, now the whole title is written.

Please cover page, abstract, report and bibliography to be on one file! The printing of the materials in the magazine is not in the order of their receipt.
